

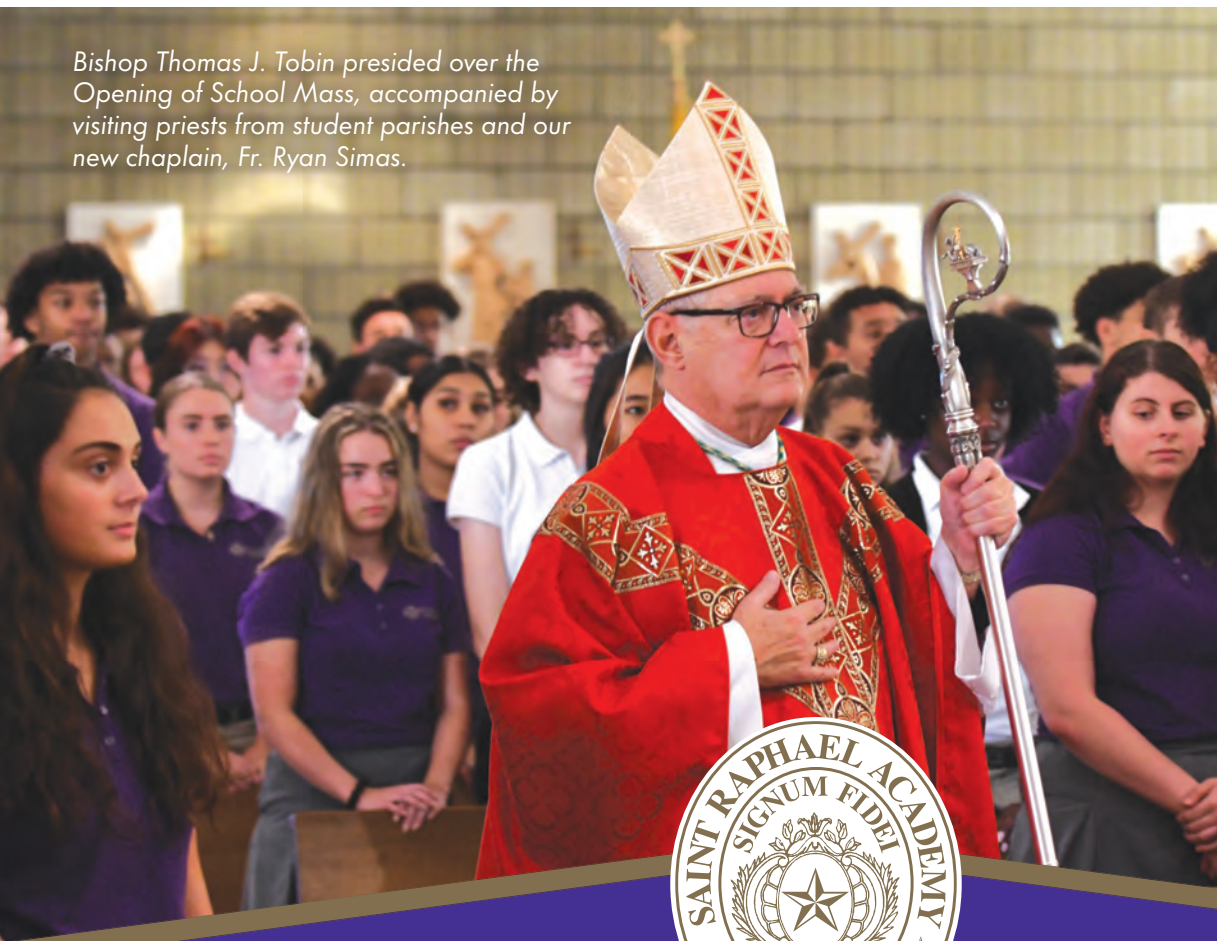

Dear Saints:

I am so thrilled to be back on campus and at my desk writing this letter to all of our wonderful SRA alumni, parents and friends. At times, the last six months have felt surreal, and it is still hard to believe we ended in-person instruction last school year on Friday, March 13, 2020. However, when we face challenges in our lives, it is also an opportunity for growth and personal development. So many of our SRA students, families and alumni stepped up during the COVID-19 pandemic and did amazing acts of kindness (see pages 5 - 6).

When we initiated our Principal's Appeal last spring, our Saint Raphael Academy supporters stepped up and answered the call. We received the most support for this appeal since I have been a principal at SRA. Simply stated, your generosity allowed us to keep families who were financially struggling due to the coronavirus pandemic at Saint Raphael Academy. The SRA Alumni Board also made a significant donation to assist SRA families in need. Their kindness and generosity during such a tumultuous time transformed many of our student's lives.

As many of you know, COVID-19 made an unexpected and unwanted visit to our campus at the end of February 2020. The virus was already in the New England region, but it opted to show itself first on Walcott Street. There were several stressful moments and challenging circumstances, but it also demonstrated the faith of our Academy and the pure kindness of our stakeholders. I am certain the prayers that were sent from our community to our Vice Principal of Student Life directly aided his battle with COVID-19. I also witnessed so many families, students, and SRA alumni support the Academy with kind words, encouraging notes, and in some cases, hot meals during these challenging times. I will never forget your gracious gestures of support!

Despite the COVID-19 virus and the restrictive nature of social distancing and mask-wearing, Saint Raphael Academy continues to thrive. Our campus has never looked more beautiful and we continue to be the third largest Catholic high school in Rhode Island. Last year our athletes won six state championships, and who knows what the final number would have been if the spring sport teams' seasons were not cancelled in March. Our students continue to matriculate to some of the finest colleges and universities in our country, and they are awarded millions of scholarship dollars annually from these institutions. All these wonderful outcomes would not happen without the prayers and support of our alumni, parents and friends—thank you!

As we continue to make great strides at our Academy, there is still much work to be done. Our biggest challenge is keeping a Saint Raphael Academy education affordable for our students. Over 75 percent of our students receive some type of financial aid from SRA, and I anticipate that number will continue to grow. The financial support that our alumni provide to our Annual Fund goes directly to our students. I know many of our alumni received their Saints education due to the kindness of others, and I am hoping you will "pay it forward." Your continuous support is critical to the success of Saint Raphael Academy; please help us keep the dedicated young men and women aspiring for a Saints education on our campus.

We welcomed hundreds of visitors to campus for the first Admissions Open House of the year on Oct. 6.

During Homecoming Week, a new tradition began by the SRA Football Team seniors. They reached out to a teacher who made an impact on their life at Saints and asked them to wear their football jersey during Saints Stride (formerly the Walkathon.)





NOVEMBER

Saints fall sports team took home THREE state titles: Boys Soccer, SRA Cheer and Girls Volleyball.

Cross-country Coach Chris Magill '90 was named Boys RI Cross Country Coach of the Year.

The new SRA Cultures Club hosted its first schoolwide event.

The faculty and staff enjoyed a day of fellowship with other RI Lasallians on a day observing the 300th anniversary of St. John Baptiste De la Salle's death and the 10th anniversary of DENA.

DECEMBER

The Drama Club hosted another stunning Winter Musical, "Tuck Everlasting." The story is based on the 1975 children's book by Natalie Babbitt which tells the story of Winnie Foster, an 11-year-old girl who meets the Tuck Family, who are seemingly eternally youthful.

The Saints for Tots Toy Drive brought in hundreds of donations, which were collected and distributed at the annual Christmas Assembly.

Our incoming Class of 2024 received their acceptances as the month closed out. They hold a special place in Saints history as the class that will graduate during our centennial celebration!



FEBRUARY

Saints students and faculty enjoyed the annual Winter Ball and underclassmen attended various retreats as we headed toward February break.

On Valentine's Day, a group of SRA students and faculty & Staff chaperones departed for what promised to be a wonderful - and unforgettable - February winter break trip to the Mediterranean coasts of Italy, Monaco, and Spain.

MARCH, when everything changed, through AUGUST

On March 1, the State of RI announced that the first presumed case of the rapidly spreading COVID-19 coronavirus was found in RI. Later, the patient was confirmed as Saint Ray's Vice Principal for Student Life Marc Thibault, who coordinated the February break trip. A student and chaperone from the trip later tested positive, as well. All eventually recovered, but this set into motion a whirlwind of change for our school, now finding itself in the local, and later national, spotlight.

SRA went to virtual learning soon after the news, where it remained throughout the school year.

Fortunately, Saints was up to the task because virtual learning had already been an integral part of our curriculum.

The Academy instituted a 1:1 program five years ago with training and professional development for all faculty, then (beginning in 2016) provided all students with laptops for use during the school year. Since then, they have become a staple in the classroom. Our faculty and students rose to the occasion and set an example for the rest of the state.

Our teachers were creative, flexible, and even more dedicated than ever, to ensure an outstanding SRA experience for our students learning from home.

We couldn't have an in-person Spring Gala, but we watched many of students' talents come to life in "Saints got Talent," a virtual talent show with musicians, poets, artists and more. Teacher Tim Boisvert continued to host his Dungeons and Dragons after-school club virtually throughout the spring, which provided an important social connection for students who were isolated at home.

SERVICE

Even though our Saints were physically separated from each other, they continued to help others.

Paul Guevremont '21 and his sister Hannah, an incoming freshman with the Class of 2024, saw an increasing need for food within their community of Pawtucket, with lines for the Pawtucket Soup Kitchen getting visibly longer during the pandemic. They were inspired to start a food drive for the soup kitchen and called it "2020 Vision to End Hunger."

Katherine and Sophia Bianchi started "Sweets from Saints," where members of our community baked treats and delivered them to their local first responders. Maddie Nault '20 challenged students to "Making Masks for Maddie," to make or collect masks for Home Hospice Care and Nurses. (her mom, Christine, is the director).



GRADUATION

The top two students in the Class of 2020 were announced, and they are both children of alums! Valedictorian is Stephanie Murphy, whose mother is Malaina Gennari Murphy '85. Salutatorian Jeanna Bateman's father is Anthony Bateman '93, and her brother is Anthony '17, who was his class valedictorian. Great Saints legacy families!!

As the year drew to a close, two veteran and beloved members of our faculty announced they would retire: Caroline Aldrich (Ed '74), theology department chair and longtime faculty member, and Raymond Tanguary, athletic director for the past six years.

Although the school year ended in June, our celebration for the Class of 2020 continued in the summer. Our newest alums from the SRA Class of 2020 enjoyed a car parade down Walcott Street Aug. 2, following a Senior Prayer Service at the Cathedral.



ALUMNI BOARD DONATIONS HELP KEEP SAINTS IN SCHOOL

Class of 1975

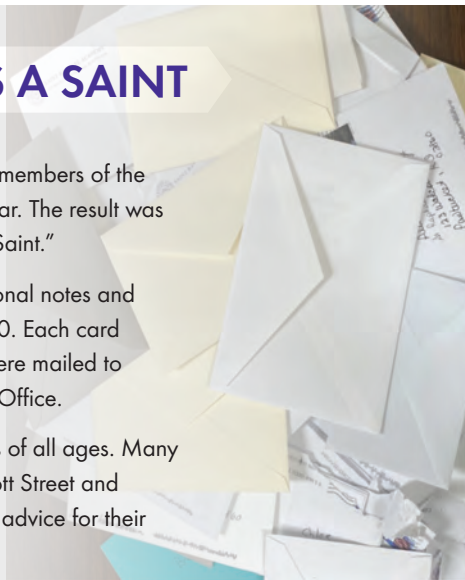
"My fellow alumni and I still spend time together while also trying to help St. Ray's move into the future, please be a part of the future of St. Ray's too."

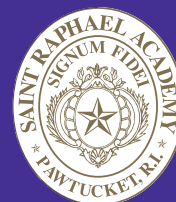

ALUM SCORES HOLE IN ONE AT GOLF TOURNAMENT

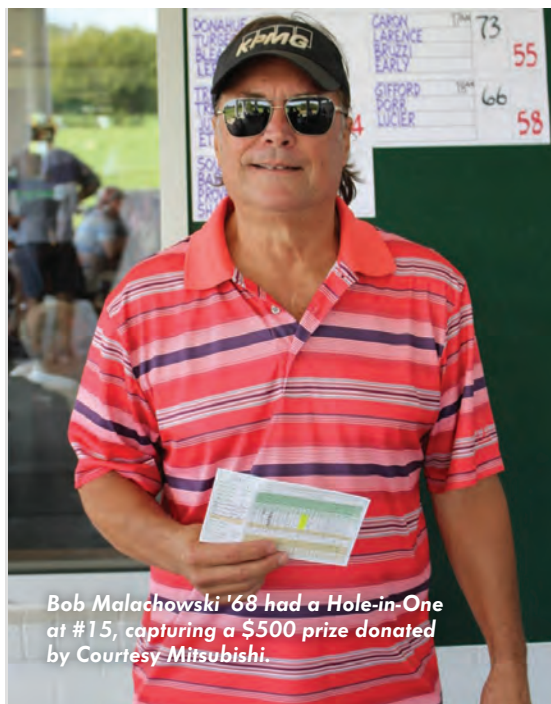
